Virtual Leadership Building (Online) Overview

NOV	Session 1 Program Expectations & Agreements	First Week of November: 2 hours FFI will introduce the program and explain the expectations each young person is expected to follow. The team will also complete communication and team agreements about how they will work together over the
	Session 2 FFI Improv Workshop	Second Week of November: 2 hours In a virtual session, FFI will introduce the building blocks of Improvisation. In addition to being a team builder, this workshop introduces skills such as public speaking, active-listening, and the importance of body language. This is a prerequisite for our speech workshops.
	Session 3 Story-Telling I: Finding History	Third Week of November: 2 hours FFI will introduce the importance of story-telling and how it plays a role in history. In this session the young people will learn how to collect personal histories and how to listen for understanding. At the end of the session, young people will receive a self-direct assignment to collect history.
DEC	Session 4 Story-Telling II: Sharing Stories	First Week of December: 2 hours In the second session, FFI will ask the young people to come prepared with their assignments from the previous session. Each young person will share the history they collected in the form of a sort story.
	Session 5 Goal Setting	Second Week of December: 2 hours FFI will introduce the concept of goal setting. In this session each individual young person will identify their person goals and team goals and identify clear action steps they can take to achieving goals.
	Session 6 Team Identity	Third Week of December: 2 hours The team will create their own team identity based on their shared goals, visions, and interests.
JAN	Session 7 Culture Exchange	First Week of January: 2 hours FFI Northern Ireland Alumni will facilitate a cultural exchange. This will include a virtual tour of Northern Ireland (including FFI's campus) and an open forum for the young people to ask questions and share.
	Session 8 TBD	Second Week of January: 2 hours Session TBD based on the team's interests selected from FFI's Curriculum Library.
	Session 9 TBD	Third Week of January: 2 hours Introduction to Public Speaking workshop.
FEB	Session 10 Culture Exchange	Fourth Week of January: 2 hours FFI Middle East Alumni will facilitate a cultural exchange based on the interests of the team. This exchange will include an open forum for the young people to ask questions and share.
	Session 11 TBD	First Week of February: 2 hours Session TBD based on the team's interests selected from FFI's Curriculum Library.
	Session 12 FFI Graduation	Second Week of February: 2 hours FFI Program Debrief and a Formal virtual FFI Graduation Ceremony. Young people will receive: • FFI Graduation Certificate • Access to additional FFI Opportunities
